History of the Yokwe Yuk

During the period of 1951-1956 activities at Kwajalein were accelerated due to its location on the supply routes for operations in the Korean, Eniwetok and Bikini areas. The Yokwe Yuk Club, built in 1952 as part of the general facility buildup on Kwajalein, was originally utilized as an officers club and mess. At the same time, an enlisted club was constructed and christened the Crossroads Club in honor of "operation crossroads", code name for the Eniwetok, Bikini operations. In 1964 with the phase out of Navy personnel, the dining areas of the Yokwe Yuk Club were renamed the Executive Dining Room and used as a mess facility for residents of the BQs. The Crossroads Club evolved into the island restaurant and opened to the general public. In 1974 the Executive Dining Room was closed and all mess members transferred to the Pacific Dining Room. The Crossroads Club was dismantled and the Yokwe Yuk Club was made available for all island residents. In 1978 the Club was completely redecorated in keeping with its new role as the island restaurant and club.
